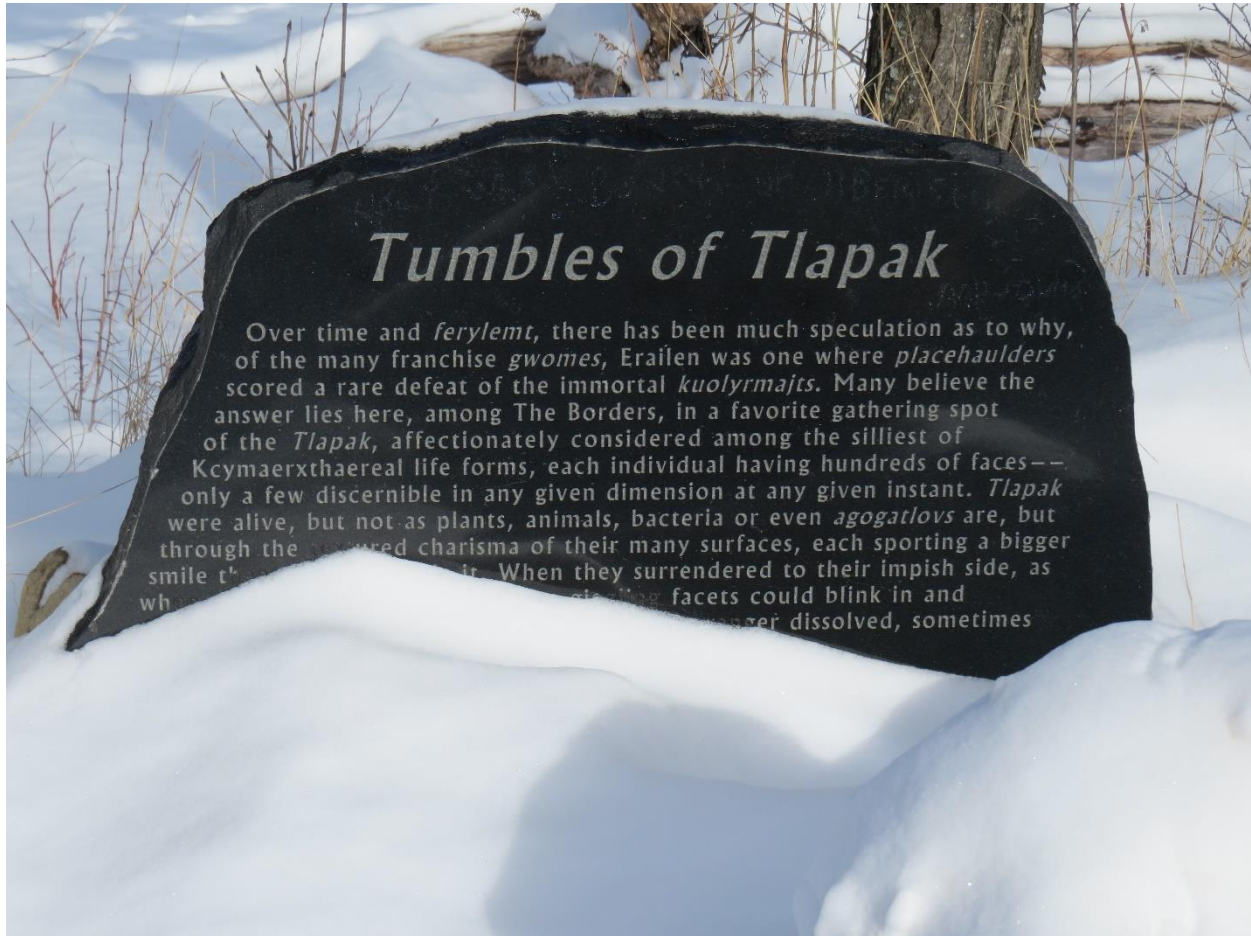

This marker was installed at its permanent location at Squaw Beach in Big Bay, Michigan, on June 17. It was originally on display in the Grand Rapids Art Museum as a part of Art Prize.
