Mark Geovjian covers the bass and guitar. A long time music partner to Frontier, they have a vast history of miles and various gigs together.

All members have full lives outside music and reside all over the country. It has become an undeniable tradition to come together every summer for a week of reunion and music, their first love. With so many years of friendship and history performing together they can't help but have fun and insist that all in
