**Oddities & Rarities** – We journey across the state to visit small towns that hide unique objects and mysteries. Learn about the unexplained artifact in Ontonagon from the old Superior Mine, the ancient artifact in Nahma, the Tomb of the Cow, the Sanilac Petroglyphs and more. A very popular program with an emphasis on forgotten Michigan history.

**Nature Getaways** – This program takes the traveler to some of the most overlooked nature areas in Michigan. Each has easy trails is accessible to anyone and is usually under 1 mile long, you don't have to be a mountain climber to enjoy these. Local attractions are discussed near each nature area so each can make for a great day trips.

**Color Tours** – We visit several regions where autumn colors are nothing short of spectacular. These color tours are found in every region of Michigan. The

program includes the Keweenaw Peninsula, islands and the forest primeval in southern Michigan.
